CBS Men's Club, in conjunction with the Federation of Jewish Men's Clubs, has been providing yellow candles each Yom Hashoah in memory of all those who perished in the Holocaust.

Many of you have made donations each year which is sincerely appreciated. Net proceeds from each program are in a Men's Club savings account.

Recently, our Men's Club board challenged itself to develop a plan to appropriately use those accrued funds. We developed the idea to design, build, and place a permanent Holocaust memorial right here on our CBS campus.

Thanks to all who contributed to our most recent Yom HaShoah fundraising program, which resulted in a record response. We are now in position to move forward, but we still need your help to make it a reality.

The plan includes:

- Designing an appropriate, meaningful memorial sculpture.
- Providing a base upon which the sculpture will be placed. It will include signage explaining the wonderful numerology of the sculpture.
- Installing a seating area on the main patio in front of the new sanctuary where one may sit, contemplate, reflect, or just be with friends. See the diagram to the right.

Your donation to help Congregation Beth Shalom make this meaningful contribution to the Jewish community of Santa Clarita is very much appreciated!

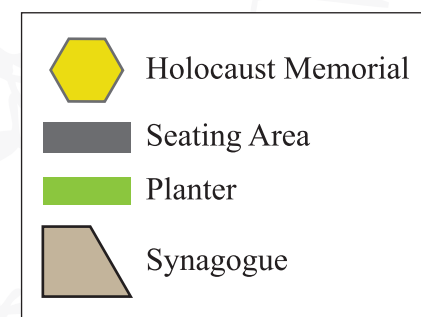
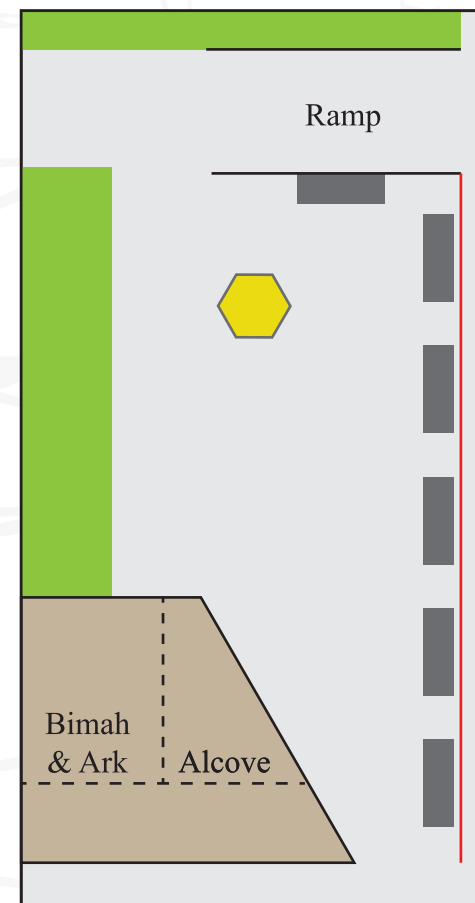
