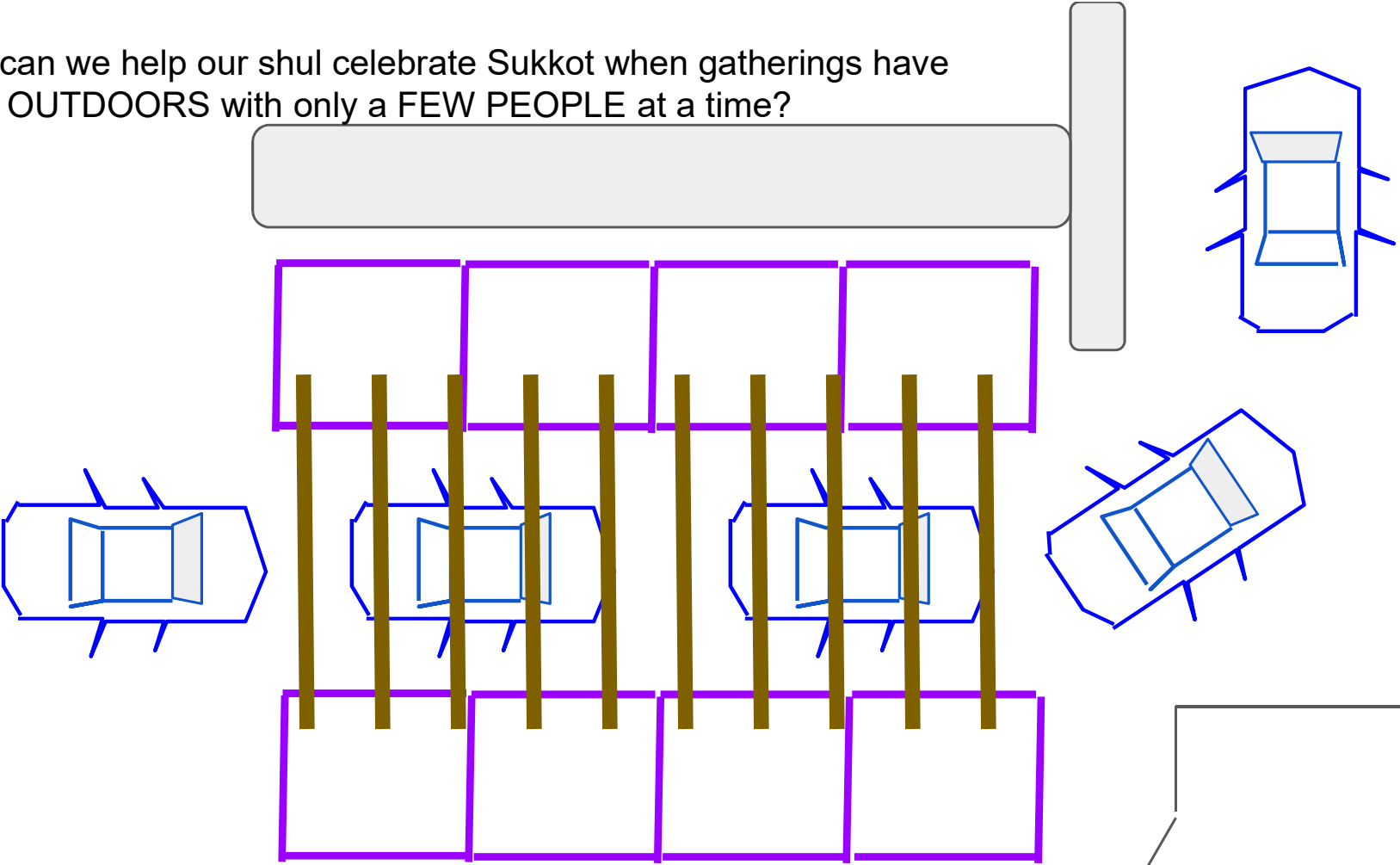


How can we help our shul celebrate Sukkot when gatherings have to be OUTDOORS with only a FEW PEOPLE at a time?

We already have the parts to build a 1,400 square foot Sukkah in our courtyard...

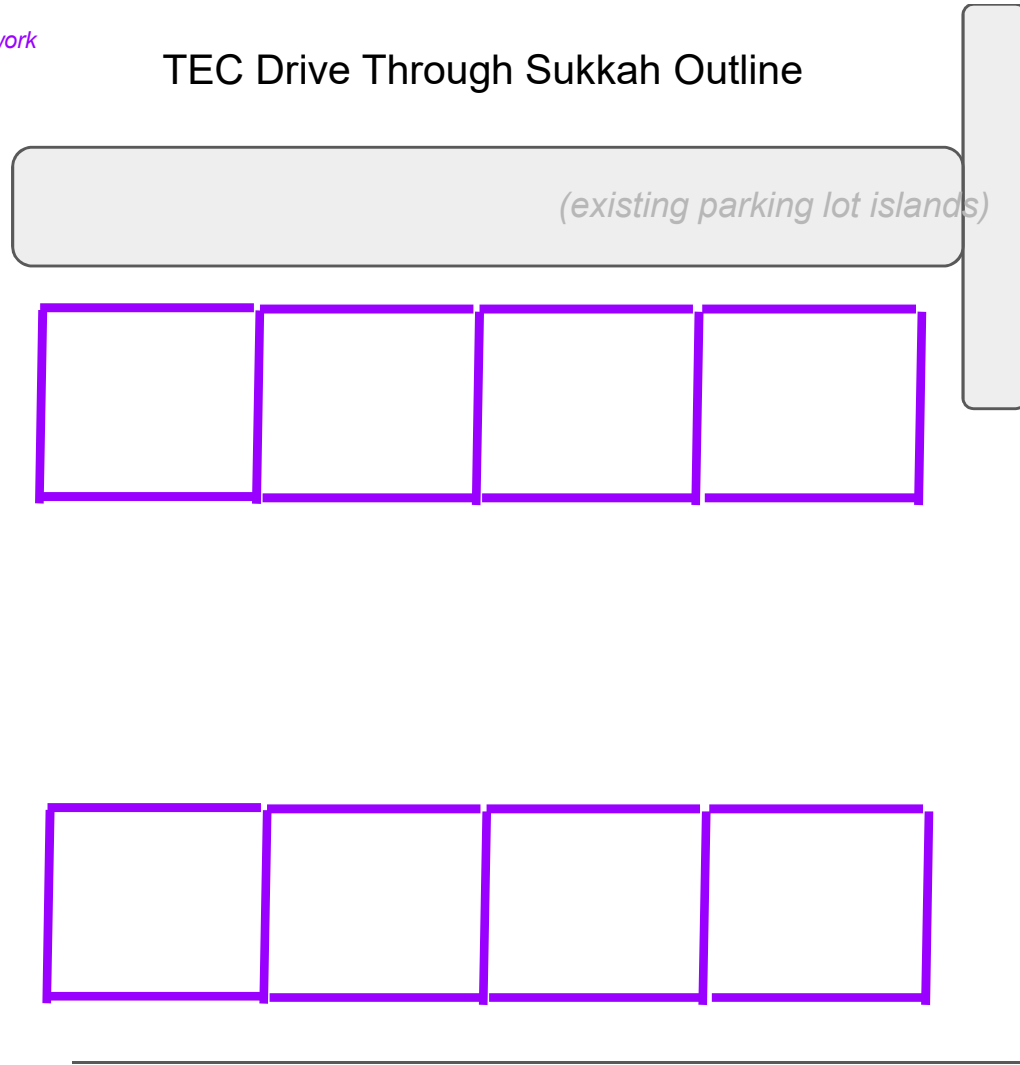
...but this year...

**Glove Dispense & Helpers\* (both sides):** "Welcome! Chag Sameach! Masks required! Everyone gets gloves but DON'T put them on until AFTER you exit your car. Two cars at a time. Please pull forward to the farthest open Sukkah spot! Engines must be shut off during Mitzvah-ing."
