This event is open to the entire community.



Dear Friends,

Yom HaShoah - Holocaust Remembrance Day - is observed worldwide on 28 Nisan, which begins this year on the evening of Sunday, April 7th.

The Temple will hold its annual remembrance service on the evening of April 7th at 7:30 p.m. Our Men's Club distributes the enclosed candle to our congregants as part of its annual *Yom HaShoah* Yellow Candle Program. By lighting this candle on the eve of *Yom HaShoah*, we fulfill the mitzvah of *zakhor* - remembering the destruction of European Jewry, and the martyrdom of the six million Jewish people in the Holocaust. A suggested reading to accompany your own personal candlelighting can be found on the back of this letter.

As in the past, the Men's Club dedicates all funds collected from the distribution of these candles to USY scholarships for the youth of our congregation who represent our future. Last year, with your help, we raised over \$1,000 for youth scholarships. With your generous assistance, we would like to do even better this year. Please return the bottom portion of this letter with your contribution to support our effort.

The *Shoah* was our people's greatest tragedy of the past century. Our response to it consists of remembering the martyrs, and ensuring the preservation of the future through our continued commitment to the spiritual, cultural and educational renaissance of the Jewish people. We hope you will join us in remembrance and help strengthen our response for the next generation.
