

## Tzedek Handbook

The following handbook in addition to the flyers will be distributed to students ages 12 – 18, by the educational directors by October 15, 2022.

The educational director will have the name and contact information for the NY Metro FJMC Club leaders within the temple assigned to this project.

If a student is interested, then the student will contact the NY FJMC representative. The student will choose a topic and then prepare a one-page summary to indicate the following:

1. Name and mission statement of project
2. Process and implementation
3. Evaluate and summarize the conclusions
4. Application to other clubs, such as FJMC or their own synagogue

The FJMC club representative will mentor and/or assist the student's progress during the project.

Each synagogue will keep a record of the student applicants.

The Executive Committee of the NY Metro FJMC will keep a master spreadsheet.

Completion of the program is April 1, 2023

The Executive Committee will choose 4 students for the awards.

These students will be required to present their projects at the discretion Of their individual club leaders.

These 4 students will be awarded a check for \$250., and a plaque to be given out at the Man of the Year Dinner. All applicants who complete their project will be given a Certificate of Achievement.
